


HOW MANY CAN I GET?: SQUARES

Use this chart to determine the number of squares that can be cut from various precuts. Yardage figures include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. The figures on this chart are mathematically accurate.

Strip Challenge

This is a great way to reduce your stash of left over 2 1/2" WOF (width of fabric) pieces and you could go home with a Jelly Roll! You would need to bring in 3 or more strips per meeting. You will receive a ticket for every 3 strips you bring in. Near the end of the business meeting there will be a drawing. You must be present at that time to win. We will continue to draw until we get a winner. This is how it works: Check the month and bring 3 or more strips representing the flower or the flower colors. Here are the FLOWERS and colors for each Month:

March DAFFODIL White, yellow, orange and green

April SWEET PEA Soft colors, pink, yellow, purple & blue.

May LILY OF THE VALLEY White in color with a hint of green.

Block of the Month

March – Double Four Patch Quilt Pattern

Use 2.5 inch strips or squares and make two (2) four patches that measure 4.5 inches unfinished.

Pair them with two 4.5 inch squares and your 4 Patch in a 4 Patch block should measure 8.5 inches unfinished.



Member News







By car:

Lowell is located 28 miles north of Boston off Interstates 93 and 495 and Route 3. From Route 3 take exit 30B northbound or exit 30A southbound onto I-495 towards. Lawrence, From I-495 take exit 35C onto the Lowell Connector, Continue about 2 miles to Exit 5B onto Thorndike St.

At the 4th light, Thorndike Street merges into Dutton Street. Go to the 2nd light and turn right onto Market Street.
