This is a great way to reduce your stash of left over 2 1/2" WOF (width of fabric) pieces and you could go home with a Jelly Roll! You would need to bring in 3 or more strips per meeting. You will receive a ticket for every 3 strips you bring in. Near the end of the business meeting there will be a drawing. <u>You must be present at that time to win</u>. We will continue to draw until we get a winner.

This is how it works: Check the month and bring 3 or more strips representing the flower or the flower colors. Here are the FLOWERS and colors for each Month:

November	CHRYSANTHEMUMS
January	CARNATION
February	VIOLET
March	DAFFODIL
April	SWEET PEA
May	LILY OF THE VALLEY

White, yellow bronze, and burgundy.White, pink, reds and purples.Blue, mauve, yellow, cream and violet.White, yellow and orange.Soft colors, pink, yellow, purple & blue.White in color with a hint of green.

#### By car:

Lowell is located 28 miles north of Boston off Interstates 93 and 495 and Route 3 From Route 3 take exit 30B northbound or exit 30A southbound onto I-495 towards Lawrence. From I-495 take exit 35C onto the Lowell Connector. Continue about 2 miles to Exit 5B onto Thorndike St

At the 4th light, Thorndike Street merges into Dutton Street. Go to the 2nd light and turn right onto Market Street.
