# NBQA General Membership Meeting 05-18-23

#### **President Gail Macera**:

The May meeting of the Narragansett Bay Quilters Association was called to order at 6:47 pm by President Gail Macera.

Before the business meeting, members could shop our boutique at greatly reduced prices. Kits for the summer challenge were available to pick up as well.

Gail asked our new members present tonight to stand and introduce themselves. Gail noted that we have 33 new members and a total of 174 current members.

Gail was pleased to announce that the boutique sales have brought in about \$4500 for the benefit of the guild activities. At our silent auction last month, we took in \$1733 and were able to donate \$862 (50%) to the New England Quilt Museum, \$431 (25%) to Meals on Wheels, and \$431 (25%) to the United Methodist Church (where we hold our meetings) for one of their missions.

Gail read the slate of officers, standing committee chairs, and key contributors for the coming year and asked if there were any nominations from the floor. The list of nominees is in the newsletter. Gail asked the secretary to cast one vote for the slate of nominees.

The hospitality position is on hold for now. Gail will send out a poll over the summer to determine if members want to have a break during the meeting for snacks or if they prefer no break so the meeting will close earlier.

Gail gave a special recognition to Anne Sabatini (Membership) and Joany Rebecchi (Hospitality) for their many years of service to the guild.

Please include a coordinating pillowcase (handmade or store bought) to give with the quilt. Voting will take place at the September meeting and cash prizes will be awarded to the top three votes. Instructions are in the newsletter.

Joan mentioned that the Newman Congregational Church at 100 Newman Avenue in Rumford, RI is hosting an exhibition this weekend featuring quilts made by the Sacred Ally Quilt Ministry in Jaffrey, NH. These quilts were created as a response to the murder of George Floyd and make statements about the pain of racism in our country.

The quilt show committee has been researching venues for a quilt show in 2024 (spring or fall). The West Warwick Civic Center has a large space with room for lots of vendors, quilt racks, parking, and even a couple of classrooms. Joan will check into available dates. A kickoff meeting to plan the next quilt show is scheduled for June 11<sup>th</sup> at Louise's shop.
