### **Supply List**

#### **Fabric Requirements:**

A full length of fabric that has at least four or eight repeats (plus a little extra for aligning). This could be anywhere from 2 1/2 - 4 yards of fabric. If you are not sure how to find the repeat, you can google it for resources and there are videos on YouTube as well. Your local quilt shop can also assist in identifying the repeat. **DO NOT cut** any of your fabric before class.

#### Fabrics that work well are:

- bold, high contrast prints
- medium to large scale prints novelty, floral, abstract
- panels
- border prints with lines and/or rounded shapes
- fabrics that would otherwise be considered "ugly ducklings" and may be in the markdown section

### Other Supplies:

- Sewing machine in good working order with a quarter inch foot
- Marking tool such as a chalk pencil, Frixion pen, etc.
- Flat head pins (not necessary but extremely helpful)
- Basic sewing supplies lots of pins, rotary cutter and mat, rulers, scissors, thread, bobbins, seam ripper, etc.
